Why is this course important?

- 10-15% of patients consult a GP for a serious illness. A proportion of these will be acutely unwell.
- The Royal College of General Practice Curriculum for the acutely unwell patient states that GPs should:
 - Be able to recognise the acutely unwell patient and take timely action.
 - Be able to work effectively in teams and co-ordinate care.
 - Act calmly in an emergency situation and follow agreed protocol
 - Recognise any need for more experienced personnel.

What do you learn from the course?

- Learning outcomes from the course include the ability to:
- Identify medical emergency, apply an ABC approach to management and initiate appropriate treatment.
- Coordinate a team's response to medical emergencies
- Assess how your own practice would manage these situations.
